1. A road rally was organized on 31st May, 2014 to observe World No Tobacco Day. The rally, flagged off by Dr. Shyamal Roy, distinguished scientist covered about 1.5 km from Jadavpur University up to Jodhpur Park. Rally carried posters and cartoons having messages on ill-effects of tobacco consumption. Messages were also spread through public announcement system and distribution of leaflets. The daily 'Aajkal' covered the event in its publication on 3rd June.
2. A road rally was held on Dec. 1, 2014 - the World AIDS Day, in Shyampur, Howrah and students of Shyampur High School took part in the rally.
3. A Bengali booklet entitled 'Swasthya Bhabna *Kichu Ajana Katha*' on health related issues has been published for free distribution to libraries of schools and offices.
4. Income Tax dept of Govt. of India have granted tax deduction u/s 80G for all donations to the association.
5. Association has initiated holding rural camps on cervical cancer awareness for women in villages under Hardah gram panchayate in Baruipur subdivision. Till March 8, 2015 3 camps could be held. Blood pressure was checked and random blood sugar tested in a Glucometer (Roche-Accuchek) for all women participants free of cost.
