1. Chittaranjan Natl Cancer Inst, Kolkata, collaborated with us in performing Visual Inspection of Cervix after application of Acetic Acid of the married rural women (30-60 years) in Chakraborty Abad village of Hardah gram panchayate. The test can identify those at risk of cervical cancer at least 5-10 years before onset of the disease.
2. A road rally was organized on 31st May, 2015 to observe World No Tobacco Day. The rally, flagged off by Shri Sachhidananda Banerjee, distinguished social worker of Bhowanipore area, covered about 1.5 km from Ganja Park. Rally carried posters and cartoons having messages on ill-effects of tobacco consumption. Messages were also spread through public announcement system and distribution of leaflets.
3. A colourful road rally was organized on Dec. 1, 2015 to observe World AIDS Day in association with Thakurpukur Vivekananda College.
